

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Antler Purchases by Larry Alchesay)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Larry Alchesay did this day come before the Tribal Council to request a modification of antler sale regulations;
- WHEREAS, Mr. Alchesay proposes to conduct purchases at Whiteriver, Carrizo and Cibecue, utilizing a certified scale; and
- WHEREAS, the Executive Director of Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division approves of the sale and will determine whether the regulations need to be amended to allow the sale; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the proposal made by Mr. Alchesay is in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. Mr. Alchesay's proposal as described herein is hereby approved.
- 2. The Tribe's WORD is hereby directed to determine whether the regulations need to be amended to allow the sale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 26, 2007</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
