



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Emergency Assistance of \$200.00 from Tribal Contributions for Stanley Parker and Genevieve Burnette)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


**WHEREAS**, two requests for emergency assistance were made this day in the amount of \$200.00 for Stanley Parker and Genevieve Burnette, whose children are in Phoenix hospitals; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that an expenditure of a total of \$400.00 from the Tribal Contributions Account is appropriate and in the best interest of both Stanley Parker and Genevieve Burnette

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. An appropriation of \$400.00 is hereby authorized for the purposes described herein, and said amount shall be deposited by the Treasurer into the Tribal Contributions Account and all budgets thereto shall be adjusted accordingly.
2. An emergency assistance expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account in the amount of \$200.00 for both Stanley Parker and Genevieve Burnette is hereby authorized for the purposes described herein.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 30, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
