



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving financial assistance for Jonah Beach)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that Jonah Beach requests financial assistance due to family member being hospitalized;


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that such assistance of \$200.00 is appropriate and in the best interest of the Beach family.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. An appropriation of \$200.00 is hereby approved and said amount shall be withdrawn from the Tribal Contributions Account by the Treasurer.
2. A financial assistance expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account is hereby authorized for Jonah Beach for the purposes described herein.
3. The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
