

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing payment to Silver Creek Mortuary for viewing body)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that Kayla Rae Antonio, whose uncle passed, is prohibited from attending his wake and funeral; and

WHEREAS, her family requests that they be allowed to view his body at Silver Creek Mortuary in Taylor, AZ; and

WHEREAS, the family further requests assistance from the Tribe for payment of \$100.00 fee for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that an expenditure of \$100.000 from the Tribal Contributions Account is appropriate and in the best interest of Kayla Rae Antonio.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- An appropriation of \$100.00 is hereby authorized for the purposes described herein, and said amount shall be deposited by the Treasurer into the Tribal Contributions Account and all budgets thereto shall be adjusted accordingly.
- 2. An emergency expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account in the amount of \$100.00 is hereby authorized to Silver Creek Mortuary for the purposes described herein.
- 3. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
