

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Emergency Assistance Expenditure of \$200.00 from Tribal Contributions for Nellie Deane)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, a request for emergency assistance in the amount of \$200.00 was made this day for Nellie Deane, a member of the Tribe, ; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that an expenditure of \$200.00 from the Tribal Contributions Account is appropriate and in the best interest of Nellie Deane; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation for said expenditure is required because the Tribal Contributions Account has not been replenished.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. An appropriation of \$200.00 is hereby authorized for the purposes described herein, and said amount shall be deposited by the Treasurer into the Tribal Contributions Account and all budgets thereto shall be adjusted accordingly.
- 2. An emergency assistance expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account in the amount of \$200.00 is hereby authorized for Nellie Deane for the purposes described herein.
- 3. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 2007 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
