



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving a Residential Lease for Tribal Member Ranlett Chee)**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** tribal member, Ranlett Chee, recently purchased the home located at Lot A-104 in the Hondah Homesites, from the EMC Mortgage Corporation, who obtained the property through foreclosure in January 2003; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Chee is requesting Tribal Council approval to lease Lot A-104 in the Hondah Homesites community; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has considered this request and concludes that permission should be granted to Ranlett Chee to lease Hondah Homesites Lot A-104.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. A residential lease between the Tribe and tribal member Ranlett Chee is hereby approved for a period of twenty-five (25) years, automatically renewable for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years, for Lot A-104 in the Hondah Homesites Community.
2. Horses or other livestock shall not be permitted on the leased premises without the consent of the Tribal Council.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JUNE 11, 2007** duly adopted by a vote of **FIVE** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
