



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Appropriating Funds and Authorizing Budget for Miss White Mountain Apache Princess
Pageant)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Committee for the Miss White Mountain Apache Princess has submitted a budget for a Pageant, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$3,000 is required to fully fund the budget requested herein; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the Committee's request is in the best interest of Apache culture and traditions; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that an appropriation should be made to fully fund the budget requested, and that the budget should be approved.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. An appropriation of \$3,000 is hereby authorized to be made from the Tribe's General Fund.
2. The Miss White Mountain Apache Princess Pageant Budget is hereby approved for expenditures, provided that justification and accounting be made for all line items therein.
3. The Controller is hereby directed to work together with the Treasurer, and the Budget and Finance Committee, and adjust any and all applicable budgets accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
