



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving a Waiver of Fees for Parenting Classes at the Veteran's Building)


- WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 12-2005-351, the Tribal Council did approve a lease between the American Legion and the Tribe for use of the Veteran's Building in Whiteriver, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribe's Department of Social Services provides parenting skills classes at the Veteran's Building, for which use the American Legion charges a fee; and
- WHEREAS**, the classes are funded by the State of Arizona through programs known as the Parenting Skills grant and the Preserving Safe and Stable Families; and
- WHEREAS**, the Department of Social Services does not receive sufficient funds to rent the Veteran's Building, and requests that the fee for its use of the Building be waived in order to maintain this vital program; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that parenting skills classes are a necessary program to create stable families, which is in the best interests of the children and their parents; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council further finds that the Tribe's lease with the American Legion should be amended such as to waive any fees for such programs as described herein.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Tribe's lease with the American Legion is hereby amended to include a provision waiving any fees for parenting skills classes provided by the Tribe's Department of Social Services.
2. The Tribe's Realty program, together with the Legal Department, is hereby directed to effect said amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 20, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
