



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing Trade-In and Purchase of Vehicle for District II Council Member Victoria Brewer)**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** a vehicle was purchased for District II Council Member Victoria Brewer pursuant to Resolution No. 05-2006-163 in order that she may fulfill her duties as a member of the Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS,** Council Member Brewer's vehicle has become inoperable due to a defective motor not covered by the warranty, which has substantially decreased its value; and

**WHEREAS,** while the vehicle is almost a total loss, it will be inappropriate for use by Council Member Brewer; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that Council Member Brewer should be provided a replacement vehicle and the wrecked vehicle should be traded in for whatever value remains; and

**WHEREAS,** given the urgency of Council Member Brewer's need for a vehicle, the Tribal Council further finds that this situation needs to be immediately addressed outside of its regularly meeting scheduled for the second week of October; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Council Member Brewer is hereby authorized to purchase a new vehicle in replacement of her existing vehicle for the purposes of fulfilling her duties as a member of the Tribal Council.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to determine the form and method of payment for said vehicles, subject to available funds.

3. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the vehicle requirement for Council Member Brewer, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairwoman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

The foregoing resolution was on October 3, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 ( and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
