



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Requesting White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to Provide an Extension for Lenora Tessay's Temporary Shelter)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Lenora Tessay did this day request an extension of her temporary lease of emergency shelter for an additional thirty days, in which time her recently purchased mobile home can be moved to her newly assigned lot across Hon-Dah station and get utility services established at the site; and

WHEREAS, the emergency shelter is managed by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and provided to Ms. Tessay, but the building is slated for rehabilitation through a federal tax credit program, which requires that Ms. Tessay relinquish the home back to the Housing Authority so that rehabilitation can commence; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Land Office has not surveyed Ms. Tessay's lot, and the U.S. Indian Health Service may require an additional time to complete water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the extenuating circumstances, the Tribal Council finds that the Housing Authority should provide an extension of Ms. Tessay's lease for an additional thirty days for the purposes of allowing her a smooth transition from the shelter unit to her new home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority is hereby requested to provide Ms. Tessay a thirty day extension of her temporary lease of emergency housing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe's Land Office is hereby directed to survey Ms. Tessay's assigned lot as soon as possible, in order that the U.S. Indian Health Service can timely complete funding of water and sewer services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the U.S. Indian Health Service is hereby requested to expedite funding of water and sewer services for Ms. Tessay's lot at Hon-dah Home Sites.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
