



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing Fair & Rodeo Department to Purchase Two Saddles)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Renee Beatty did this day report certain discrepancies in the Tribal Fair & Rodeo's Junior Rodeo results; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Beatty's children and other family member participants were not awarded saddles due to these discrepancies when they clearly should have received them; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Ms. Beatty's children and other family members should receive saddles due them; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directs the Fair & Rodeo Department to purchase two saddles for Ms. Beatty's family members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that: the Fair & Rodeo Department is hereby directed to purchase two saddles for the Beatty family members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
