

Meeting called to order and roll call at 9:25 a.m.

1. Arthur Riley and Dell Riley - Requesting for board to look into the land that his father had turned over to him. He stated that Mariddie Craig is still giving them a hard time, but according to Mr. Riley, he stated that way back when the family were still living down there, Ms Craig's family weren't there yet, and later on her parents needed a place so they were given that small portion for them to live. Ms. Craig did have an application on the land but not the same area that Mr. Riley is claiming. Mr. Riley brought some documents on the land that was dated 1964 and 1977. The documents are land assignment of building sites and the summary probate in the matter of the Estate of Ida Kaytoggy. The board made the decision on this matter by the documents by allowing Arthur on this land to be final.
2. Eunice Pinal /Jolene Pinal – Inquiring on cornfield (Farm 178 Penstock Ditch in North Fork) that belonged to her late mother, the cornfield was about 5 acres, until the late Luther Ethelbah Sr., had claimed a lot of it but according to Ms. Pinal this field belong to Clorinda Bahlen and Lillian Clark. She is asking for part of the land so that she may put it in her daughter Jolene Pinal's name. There are other people involved in this matter, so the board are requesting for them to attend the next meeting and will put this on hold until then.
3. Ida Manuel/Rosie Foster and Emily Danford – Return to check on the status of the cornfield in Carrizo. The Board asked Raymus to asked the council about this matter then we will get back with the family.
4. Tiffany Kinney – Requesting to relinquish the landsite in Hondah back to the Tribe and applying for another site in McNary. The testing at Hondah had failed so that was reason for relinquishing it. Board approved the relinquishment and the new application for landsite.
5. Michelle Tate – Requesting to relinquish her landsite in Jurassic Park back to the tribe, and applying for another one in Hondah on Boundary line Rd. Board approved the relinquishment and the new application for landsite.
6. Duane Alchesay – Renewing his landsite application for Alchesay Flats. Board approved the request.
7. Crystal Riley - Applying for land in Canyon Day, land is available, Board approved the request.
8. Rhodesia Harvey - Requesting for land in North Fork, the site belongs to the North Fork Livestock Association. The livestock approved the request for her and the land Board approved this request.
9. Darrell Clendon – Requesting for land in McNary, McDaniel found the site for him, board approved the request.
10. Trish Gooday – Requesting for land in Dry Valley area, board approved the request.

11. Evelyn Massey – Renew farmland application on the field in North Fork. Board approved the request.
12. McNary Apache Baptist Church – Application was already passed at the council meeting, needed board members signature. Board signed the application.
13. Chester Bonito – Applying for land in Rainbow City, board denied the request due to the land already assigned.
14. Lehman Chee – Applying for land in Whiteriver, near FATCO, need relinquishment paper from Winston Tortice. Application put on hold.
15. Rebecca Beach – Renewing landsite application for land in Whiteriver, and to have her daughter add on with her. Board approved the request.
16. Alvina A. Alekay Madsen – Applying for land in Hondah, behind the smoke shop. She drew the map but McDaniel didn't find the area she claimed to have marked by putting a plastic bag to show the area she is requesting for. Application put on hold, will get back in touch with her.
17. Eddie Albert – Applying for famland in East Cedar Creek, Board approved the request.
18. Albert, Tulene Family – Applying for farmland in North Fork, NF Baha. Board approved the request.
19. Eddie Albert, Robert Albert, Ruthie Tulene, Dorcus Albert & her 4 children – Applying for farmland in Forest Dale. Board approved the request.
20. Clara Ruth Albert-Tulene - Applying for farmland in Cedar Creek, Cedar Creek L.S. south of Silver Butte. Board approved the request.
21. Robert & Dorcus Albert and Family – Applying for farmland in Cedar Creek, Cedar Spring Road. Board approved the request.
