



Meeting opened up in prayer by Emily Martine at 9:00 a.m.

1. Eunice Pinal., Joleen Pinal, Cora Walker, Mary Massey, Wayne Dahkoshay, Bonito, Leta Henry, - Requesting to claim some of the farmland located in Whiteriver, down below across the Riverside ball park. This farmland once belonged to Lilly E. Clark, which is Eunice Pinal's mother. Ms. Pinal has the assignment agreement date October 5, 1960, on this farming land which is the Farm 11 B on Penstock Ditch in North Fork District on Ft. Apache Indian Reservation. The family members also have documents on the farmland which is dated July 8, 1941, this document is the last will and testament by Ida Toggie pertaining to her shares. She had given equal shares to 3 of her grandchildren which are Luther Ethelbah Sr., William Colelay and Clarinda Bahlen and today the most of the farmland is claimed by the late Luther Ethelbah and the family members are requesting for some of that land back in their name. These individuals claim that their parent is a part of the family but they don't have any part of it. Ms. Bonito wants a part of the farmland for her family. Raymus told the members that he did go and check out the land and he is going to need more time, and with everyone wanting this farmland they would probably have to take it back to court, he also let them know that Luther Ethelbah, Sr., Leta Henry and Manley Dahkoshay are the only ones that have assignment for this farmland. The family are to mark the area at the farmland and Raymus will go back out there to check it out. Hold till next meeting.
2. Garry Thompson - Requesting for farmland in Kinishba. This area he had applied for before and the board asked him to get approval from the livestock. He brought this back with the signatures, board put in on hold until application is signed.
3. Stevensen Henry – Requesting for landsite in Turkey Creek near the Apache Dawn homes. Board approved the application.
4. Dewayne White – Requesting for landsite in Turkey Creek near the Apache Dawn homes. Board approved the request.
5. Kayla Davis – Requesting for land in Hondah to put a mobile home on, she is living off reservation and would like to move back. Board approved the application.

6. Violet Caddo - Updating landsite application on lot in Cibecue, Raymus asked to check with Revolving Credit first. Application on Hold.
7. Marlana Loas – Relinquishing landsite in Hondah back to Tribe and applying for another one in Hondah. Board approved the request.
8. Alexander Alchesay - Applying for land in Hondah, Board approved the request.
9. Johanna Alchesay – Applying for land in Hondah right next to Alexander Alchesay’s lot. Board approved the request.
10. Marlinda Classay – Relinquishing land in Dry Valley back to Tribe, and applying for another one in Hondah. Board approved the request.
11. Adair Lee Wapaha – Requesting for land in Hondah on Block C, Board approved the request.
12. Letitia Quintero – Renewing application for lot in Cedar Creek. Board approved the request.
