

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing Reinstatement of Saralyn Riley)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Saralyn Riley, an enrolled member of the Tribe and an employee of the White Mountain Apache Judicial Court, did this day inform the Tribal Council of an unjustified employee action against her; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Riley requests that she be reinstated to her position of Technical Assistant and that she be re-considered for the position funded by the U.S. Department of Justice; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Ms. Riley's request and finds that Ms. Riley should continue in her position full-time or eighty hours per pay period until such time as funds are depleted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. The Tribal Court is hereby directed to reinstate Saralyn Riley to the position of Technical Assistant eighty hours per pay period effective December 12, 2007, and until such time as funds are depleted.
- 2. The Tribal Court is further directed to re-consider Ms. Riley for the position of Protective Order Monitor as funded by the U.S. Department of Justice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 2007 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
