

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Cease radio reports for Chairman, Vice Chairman, Tribal Council and Candidates for Public Office)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is preparing for another election, scheduled for February 6, 2008 for the Primary Election and April 2, 2008 for the General Election; and
- WHEREAS, it is customary that all members of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman and Vice-Chairman as at-large members, cease their local radio reports on KNNB-FM during the election period; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that candidates for public office within the Tribe, such as Council Member positions, should be similarly banned from making reports of any kind on KNNB until the day after the General Election, even if such report is made within a professional capacity or as an employee of the Tribe or its enterprises; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that a cessation of radio reports is in the best interests of the Tribe, and that the reports should resume after tribal elections have been held.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all radio reports on KNNB-FM cease for the Chairman, Vice Chairman and members of the Tribal Council, as well as for candidates for public office, effective immediately until the day after the General Election.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 28, 2007</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
