



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving transfer of four vans to the Tribal Council)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council discussed the high level of transportation needs for providing government services and related requests of their constituents; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Resolution No. 12-2007-525, the Division of Health Programs did seek to dispose of certain vehicles from its fleet; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council recommends that four vans from the Division of Health Programs be instead transferred to the Tribal Council as follows: two vans for use by the Tribal Council, one van each to the Offices of Chairman and Vice Chairwoman.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that four vans from the Division of Health Programs be transferred to the Tribal Council as indicated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on February 28, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
