

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Terminating the Assistant Chief of WMAPD)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Division of Public Safety did advise the Tribal Council that the White Mountain Apache Police Department ("WMAPD") did lose the Indian Highway Safety Grant due to certain failures in the administration of the grant; and
- WHEREAS, the Executive Director further informed the Tribal Council of other problems within the WMAPD, including the P.L.93-638 contract with the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Interior for law enforcement services; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that new leadership is required for the administration of WMAPD.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Executive Director of the Division of Public Safety is hereby authorized to effect the termination of the Assistant Chief of WMAPD, Everett Little Whiteman.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 16, 2008</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
