



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Endorsing Bernard Huser, Candidate, Navajo County Sheriff)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Bernard Huser did this day present his candidacy for Navajo County Sheriff before the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Tribal Council concurs and finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe that the Tribe endorse Mr. Huser's candidacy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The candidacy of Bernard Huser for Navajo County Sheriff is hereby endorsed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
