

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Use of Van for Cosen Family to Attend Graduation)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Elmer Cosen, a member of the Tribe, did this day request a van from the White Mountain Apache Tribe in order for his family to attend the graduation of his son, Neomiah Cosen, from the Marine Corps in San Diego, California, July 9-12, 2008; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Neomiah Cosen's graduation and membership in the Marine Corps to be commendable; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that Mr. Cosen should be provided a van for the purposes described herein, subject to availability to be determined by the Office of the Chairman.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a van shall be provided to the Cosen family for the purposes described herein, subject to availability to be determined by the Office of the Chairman.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 24, 2008</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
