



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**(Granting ownership and title of Community Development Corporation (CDC) housing unit to
Margaret Cook)**

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** tribal member Margaret Cook has requested that the Tribal Council assign the CDC home (which she currently occupies) to her; and
- WHEREAS,** Ms. Cook has lived in this home for many years and she did request the home from the CDC Board/Director who referred her to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the home may require repairs/improvements which shall be the responsibility of Ms. Cook; and
- WHEREAS,** Margaret Cook is requesting ownership of the CDC house.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Ownership and title of the CDC home is hereby granted to tribal member Margaret Cook.
2. As a condition of this transfer of ownership, Margaret Cook shall be responsible for securing a land assignment or residential lease for CDC home, and is prohibited from selling said home for a period of three years from the date of this Resolution and selling of the housing unit will require Council approval.
3. The Legal Department is hereby directed to prepare transfer of ownership documents which relieves the Tribe of any further responsibility for maintenance and repairs of the said home.
4. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 16, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
