FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**(Appointing Judy Dehose as the Principal Investigator)**


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Division of Health Programs (DHP) for the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been responsible for the delivery of health services for many years; and
- WHEREAS,** the Johns Hopkins University – Native American Research Centers for Health (NARCH) Program, Whiteriver Center, is responsible for conducting Health Research projects and studies; and
- WHEREAS,** after much review and consideration, the Tribal Council concludes that these two (2) health agencies, the DHP and the NARCH Program, should work jointly for overall health improvement; and
- WHEREAS,** due to the lack of active participation in the monthly meetings and activities held by the Johns Hopkins and the lack of diplomatic and respectful representation of the present Principal Investigator, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby moves to replace Mariddie J. Craig.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the DHP be responsible for and to oversee the NARCH program projects and studies, and that Judy Dehose with twenty years experience on the Tribal Council, presently serving as Chairperson of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Board, be appointed Principal Investigator.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
