



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Employment of Richard James Palmer, Jr. as the Assistant Tribal Attorney for the White Mountain Apache Tribe)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(c) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council has the power to employ legal counsel; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Tribal Attorney has recommended to the Tribal Council that Richard James Palmer, Jr. be employed with the White Mountain Apache Tribe as Assistant Tribal Attorney; and

WHEREAS, Richard James Palmer, Jr. is a member of the Arizona State Bar Association in good standing; and

WHEREAS, he is also a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and entitled to Tribal member preference in hiring; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Tribal Attorney has provided the Tribal Council with a copy of Mr. Palmer's resume of education and work experience; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Richard James Palmer, Jr. is well qualified to act as the Assistant Tribal Attorney for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Richard James Palmer, Jr. is hereby hired as the Assistant Tribal Attorney for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
2. Richard James Palmer, Jr. will begin with a salary of \$80,000 and with a moving expense of \$3,000.
3. The Chairman or, in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 19, 2008 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
