

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Accepting the Resignation of Stanley Parker, Whiteriver Athletic Director)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that Stanley Parker, Whiteriver Athletic Director, submitted his resignation to Frank Endfield, Jr., Community Services Director; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council advised that Mr. Endfield accept Mr. Parker's resignation and temporarily employed Jimmy Newhall to this position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Frank Endfield, Jr., the Community Services Director, accept Stanley Parker's resignation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby temporarily appoints Jimmy Newhall to the position of Whiteriver Athletic Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
