WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approval of Land Assignment for Rose of Sharon Pentecostal Church)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council heard testimony from Pastor Samson Hinton regarding the land board's prior approval of a land assignment for the purpose of building the Rose of Sharon Pentecostal Church near the North Fork Convenience Store; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Plan and Project Review committee also approved the land assignment; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council encourages the advancement of Indian arts and culture finds it is in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize the land assignment for the purpose of building the Rose of Sharon Pentecostal Church near the North Fork Convenience Store.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a land assignment for the purpose of building the Rose of Sharon Pentecostal Church near the North Fork Convenience Store.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 22, 2009 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
