

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Council requests all P.L. 93-638 programs to submit scope and budget.)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and

act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is responsible for overseeing

program budgets related to Public Law 93-638; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it is in the best interest of the Tribe to prevent potential

fiscal issues that may interfere with the operations of our tribal organizations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all P.L. 93-638 programs shall present their budget and scope of work to the Tribal Council as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this resolution conflicts with prior resolutions or policies, this resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
