

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Letter of Concern to Don Davis of Indian Health Services)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache

Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all

matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2008, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe sat on an

interview panel regarding the CEO position of the Whiteriver Service Unit; and

WHEREAS, several applicants for the CEO position were interviewed, and after much deliberation, the

Tribal Council selected three potential candidates for the position; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was of the understanding that the CEO would be selected from among the

Tribe's approved candidates, but this did not occur; and

WHEREAS, allegations of mistreatment of staff and patients have been raised and Tribal Attorney Lee

advises the Tribal Council to direct Don Davis to investigate these allegations and report to the

Council within two weeks; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its disappointed with the results of the appointment and

believes it is in the best interest of the Tribe to communicate with Don Davis of Indian Health

Services (IHS) regarding the aforementioned allegations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Chairman to send a letter to Don Davis expressing the Tribal Council's disappointment with how the CEO vacancy was handled and to direct Don Davis to investigate allegations of mistreatment of staff and patients and Don Davis shall report with findings to the Tribal Council within two weeks.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any inconsistency with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 11, 2009 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
