

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Financial Assistance to Evangeline Warwick)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe encourages tribal members to work hard and educate themselves in order to help build and promote the Tribe's economy and culture; and

WHEREAS, Evangeline Warwick, a tribal member, has earned her second Master's Degree from the University of Arizona and requests financial assistance from the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Tribe to approve financial assistance in the amount of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) to Ms. Warwick as well as recognize her for striving to achieve greater heights through education.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves financial assistance to Evangeline Warwick in the amount of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) and further recognizes and applauds her higher educational achievements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with prior Resolutions or Policies, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 2009, adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (k), (t), (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
