



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving emergency financial assistance to Gilbert Childs)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Tribal member Gilbert Childs this day has reported to the Tribal Council that his vehicle was stolen from his daughter's apartment in Phoenix, Arizona; and


WHEREAS, he requests financial assistance to have the vehicle returned; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Mr. Childs should be assisted with \$200 from the Tribal Contributions Account.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an emergency financial assistance of \$200.00 to Gilbert Childs from the Tribal Contributions Account.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 19, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
