



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Waiver of Memorial Hall Fees)**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council was informed that the 8<sup>th</sup> grade class wishes to hold their graduation dance in the Memorial Hall on May 28, 2009; and


**WHEREAS,** the class is requesting a waiver of Memorial Hall fees; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council agrees to waive Memorial Hall fees for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation dance on May 28, 2009.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a waiver of the Memorial Hall fees for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation dance on May 28, 2009.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 19, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
