

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Financial Assistance for Michelle Johnson)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and

act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe encourages Tribal Members to

pursue higher education; and

WHEREAS, Michelle Johnson, a member of the Tribe, is enrolled and will attend Apollo College in

Mesa, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Michelle Johnson requests financial assistance for housing and utility expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to help Ms. Johnson.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Michelle Johnson is hereby awarded seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) for housing and utility expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this resolution conflicts with a prior resolution, this one shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 4, 2009</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
