



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(In Memory Of Chairman Ronnie Lupe's Brother)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has learned that Chairman Ronnie Lupe's brother recently passed away; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports Chairman Ronnie Lupe as he mourns the loss of his brother; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it appropriate to donate a cow along with two hundred and fifty (\$250) dollars on behalf of the Tribe to show support for his leadership and resolve during this difficult time.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Chairman Ronnie Lupe is hereby granted two-hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) and a donation of a cow from the Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 10, 2009 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
