



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing an Emergency Assistance Expenditure for Blaine Nosie, Sr.)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, a request for emergency assistance was made on behalf of Mr. Blaine Nosie, Sr., a Tribal member; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the request is to help defray costs of lodging, meals and fuel while assisting Blaine Nosie, Jr., who is hospitalized at the Maricopa County Hospital in Phoenix, Arizona after suffering from complications due to injuries he received in a vehicular accident; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that an expenditure of \$500 is appropriate to assist Blaine Nosie, Sr. and his family; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the emergency assistance requested should be provided.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an emergency assistance expenditure in the amount of \$500 for Blaine Nosie, Sr. and his family for the purposes described herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (d), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
