

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving the Submission of PL 93-638 AZ2007-1-BIA ERFO)

- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the capability to enter into a P.L. 93-638 contract to provide labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to complete road repair project and to provide road repair monitoring on said projects; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe intends to contract for the roads disaster repair and monitoring of Roads repairs within ERFO AZ2007-1-BIA utilizing all available funds designated for this project under a P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has identified their contract administration budget, roads repair monitoring budget and statement of work in the attached documents; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe will establish a separate roads disaster repair account with in the Tribal Grants and contracts accounting system to be used strictly for payment of encumbrances in the repair of AZ2007-1-BIA; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe agrees to enter into an agreement with the Tribal Public Works Department and Fort Apache Timber Company to implement repairs for road and bridge damages caused during FY 2007; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests that BIA/FHWA agree to negotiate increased repair costs made to repairs of Federal Facilities which may be beyond the cost estimates made for AZ2007-1-BIA; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs-Western Regional Office to implement the procedures for execution of a roads maintenance contract for AZ2007-1-BIA and obligate all available funds awarded for this project and obligate 6.5% of the Tribes IRR Construction funds for the Monitoring of this contract.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe does hereby approve the submission of a P.L. 93-638 ERFO contract for repair of federal Facilities (road and bridges), AZ2007-1-BIAstatement of work and budget available funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JULY 9, 2009</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


