**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving and Requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs place the FAIR Rt.103 Dark Shadows and FAIR Rt. 101 North Whiteriver Police Department Road Streets Project, on the 2009 ARRA Projects list utilizing all unused ARRA funding designated for WMAT)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Committee recommends that the two projects Dark Shadows and North Whiteriver Police Department Streets be placed on the Tribe's priority listing, as it presents an urgent safety need to the community and school in Whiteriver; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Transportation Committee at a duly convened meeting on June 11, 2009, did approve and recommended that the White Mountain Apache Tribe request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs place FAIR Rt. 103 Dark Shadows and FAIR Rt. 101 North Whiteriver Police Department Streets Project on the ARRA Projects list for 2009 and recommend that competitive contract procedures be pursued immediately by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Region Office; and


WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration, the Tribal Council concurs with the Tribal Transportation Committee's recommendation that it is in the best interest of the Transportation Systems within Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs place the Dark Shadows and North Whiteriver Police Department Streets Project on the 2009 ARRA, list of BIA Projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JULY 9, 2009** duly adopted by a vote of **SEVEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
