

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Financial Aid for Delitha Livingston's Program in Washington, D.C.)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache

Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all

matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Delitha Livingston is currently pursuing an advanced degree at the University of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Livingston, a tribal member, has been selected to participate in a program in Washington,

D.C., but has been unable to secure a summer job to provide funding to attend the program; and

WHEREAS, family and other avenues of funding have been explored, yielding minimal results, therefore the

Tribal Council is being asked to consider providing financial assistance to help Ms. Livingston

realize her potential and allow her to attend the program in Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe encourages education and supports the

pursuit of advanced degrees by Apache students seeking an academic challenge; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to approve this request for

financial assistance so that Ms. Livingston may participate in the program in Washington, D.C.,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$400 for Delitha Livingston so that she may travel to Washington, D.C., and further her education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JULY 15, 2009</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
