



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Directing Councilman Beach to Secure a Van For Guy Family's Trip to Kentucky)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports education and encourages Tribal Members to learn and advance their skills so they may help further the overall educational goals of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Theo Guy, a Tribal Member, asks the Tribal Council to secure a van for him to use so that his family may attend their son's graduation ceremony in Kentucky on September 18, 2009; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to honor this request and recommends that Councilman Arnold Beach be assigned with the task of securing a van for the Guy family's trip to Kentucky, provided proper insurance is retained.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Theo Guy's request for travel assistance and directs Councilman Arnold Beach to make the appropriate arrangements to secure a van, providing proper insurance is retained, so that the Guy family may travel to Kentucky for the graduation ceremony of Theo Guy's son on September 18th.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
