

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing IGA to Provide Forensic Science Services to Tribe's Police Department)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe understands that the Tribal Police Department is limited in its ability to provide forensic science services to the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requests that the Tribal Council consider authorizing the Police Department to enter an Intergovernmental Agreement, incorporated by reference, with the State of Arizona for the purpose of providing much needed forensic services to the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for the services provided by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS), the White Mountain Apache Tribe agrees to compensate DPS for services provided; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it is in the best interest of the Tribe to enter an IGA with the State of Arizona to provide the Tribe's Police Department with forensic science services.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Arizona, on behalf of the Tribal Police Department, for the purpose of providing the Tribe with much needed Forensic Science Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 8, 2009 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
