



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Pay Increase for Cheyanne Burnette)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined that Cheyanne Burnette should receive an increase in her salary; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined that this pay increase should go into effect immediately and should be retroactive for two pay periods.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. Cheyanne Burnette's salary shall be increased to \$50,000 a year.
2. This pay increase shall be retroactively effective for two pay periods.
3. Any and all necessary paperwork shall be administered by the personnel department to facilitate this resolution.
4. In the event of a conflict with a pre-existing resolution, this resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 14, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
