

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## ( Directing Legal Department to Review Delberta Childs' Business Plan )

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe regularly issues business licenses for Tribal Members and other parties who are interested in conducting business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (Reservation); and

WHEREAS, Delberta Childs requests that the Tribal Council consider approving a business license so that she may deal in scrap metals on the Reservation and pursue additional activities as opportunities arise; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to direct the Legal Department to review Delberta Childs' business plan and advise her so that she may present it to the Council at a later date for final review.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Legal Department to review Delberta Childs' business plan and to advise her and the Tribal Council on the feasibility of the plan for a final review and determination of whether a business license should be granted for the purpose of dealing in scrap metals on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 14, 2010</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
