

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## (Requesting BIA to Release Funding For Construction and Design of Rick Lupe Management Building)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that federal funding is available via PL 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) for the Tribe to design and construct the Rick Lupe Fire Management building (facility); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is requesting the BIA to make available all funding that has been allocated for the purpose of designing and constructing the facility and any funds that may become available in the future for the purposes described herein, shall be used by the Tribe to facilitate the completion of the Rick Lupe Fire Management building; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to immediately secure all available funding for the purpose described herein, because the BIA has informed the Tribe that the funds would otherwise be swept and made unavailable; and

**WHEREAS,** given the urgency of the request, the Tribal Council further finds that this needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and

whereas, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council members is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs to release any allocated funds for the purpose of paying for design and construction costs for the completion of the Rick Lupe Fire Management Building.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that funds become available in the future for the purposes described hereto, such funds shall be used by the Tribe to facilitate the completion of the Rick Lupe Fire Management building.
