

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing PBS to Film Skateboard Community on Fort Apache)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Michael Rossi, an employee of WBGH out of Boston, is interested in filming and working with White Mountain Apache Youth to publicize the positive efforts of members of the Skateboard Community to help Tribal Members stay out of trouble; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rossi requests the Tribal Council to approve a PBS production that would feature members of the White Mountain Apache Skateboard Community; and

WHEREAS, the production would result in a series that is scheduled to be premiered nationally on PBS beginning January 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to approve of Michael Rossi's request allowing PBS to produce a show to be filmed on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (Reservation).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes PBS to film on the Reservation to promote the achievements of the Tribe's Skateboard Community and the positive impact that the Community has on Tribal Member youths.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 2010, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
