



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Lorinda Nashio's request to change Sunrise Dance Location)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council Secretary maintains a schedule of Sunrise Dance Ceremonies on a yearly basis to make sure that no inconsistencies occur between the Sponsoring families; and
- WHEREAS,** tribal member and Sponsor, Lorinda Nashio, requested for a change of location of her granddaughters Sunrise Dance from FireBox, Eastfork to Maverick; and
- WHEREAS,** the ceremony is scheduled for July 2, 3 and 4, 2010; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to honor and adopt the Sunrise Dance location change presented by Lorinda Nashio.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Sunrise Dance to take place in Maverick for Lorinda Nashio's granddaughter during the weekend of July 2, 3 and 4, 2010.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 2, 2010 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
