



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approval for John Hopkins Center to utilize the bus from Hon-Dah Casino)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** Johns Hopkins, in partnership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe has agreed to assist in efforts to find ways to raise the self-sufficiency of Indian communities to the highest possible level and to promote and celebrate all that is healthy and positive in the lives of our Native Youth; and
- WHEREAS,** the annual Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp is scheduled for June 9 – 12, 2010 in Albuquerque, New Mexico; and
- WHEREAS,** the Johns Hopkins staff request to use the Hon-Dah Casino Employee bus so that three of their chaperones and eighteen Tribal member students may attend the annual Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to authorize the John Hopkins staff to utilize the Hon-Dah Casino Employee bus for participation in the 2010 Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby:

1. Approves for the John Hopkins Program staff to utilize the Hon-Dah Casino Employee bus for participation in the 2010 Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp.
2. All necessary arrangements and discussion are to be coordinated with the Hon-Dah Casino Manager.
3. The John Hopkins Program is directed to use their insurance to cover any accidents that may occur during the duration of the trip.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

Resolution No. 06-2010-150

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 7, 2010 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
