



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Rescinding Resolution No. 06-2010-144 and Authorizing
Two Trucks to be used by the Fair and Rodeo)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Council previously adopted Resolution No. 06-2010-144 wherein a Ford pickup was removed from the Cibecue Athletic Department, for the use of the Fair and Rodeo Department; and

WHEREAS, Blaine Nosie, the Fair and Rodeo Manager, has requested the use of Milfred Cosen's old Ford pickup truck and the old livestock truck, instead of the Ford pickup mentioned above; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize Mr. Nosie's request mentioned herein and to rescind Resolution No. 06-2010-144 so that the Ford pickup mentioned therein can be returned to the Cibecue Athletic Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Fair and Rodeo Manager to use Milfred Cosen's old Ford pickup truck and the old livestock truck for tribal purposes only and rescinds Resolution No. 06-2010-144 and directs the Fair and Rodeo Manager to return the Ford pickup mentioned therein to the Cibecue Athletic Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and any other Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JUNE 9, 2010** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
