



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing Intergovernmental Agreement with Whiteriver Unified School District #20)**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 and the Tribal Police Department seek to collaborate on a School Safety Program that would benefit Alchessay High School; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council desires to enter an Intergovernmental Agreement between Whiteriver Unified School District #20 and the White Mountain Apache Tribe that will place a School Resource Officer to serve the purpose of the School Safety Program; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council believes it is in the best interest of the Tribe to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 in order to carry out the goals of the School Safety Program.


**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council hereby agrees to the provisions set out in the Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 and the White Mountain Apache Tribe to place a School Resource Officer that will conduct the duties necessary to carry out the goals of the School Safety Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that in the event that this resolution conflicts with any other resolution or policy, this resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JUNE 9, 2010** duly adopted by a vote of **TEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
