

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## (Approval for Janet Roosevelt Craig to Encumber her Leased Premises located at Hondah Homesites)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Janet (Roosevelt) Craig presently occupies a home in the Hondah Community, which was constructed pursuant to a leasehold mortgage with Wells Fargo Home Mortgage through the HUD 184 program; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Craig was recently able to refinance her mortgage and is requesting permission from the Tribe to encumber the premises for the refinancing, which is required according to her lease agreement with the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has reviewed this request and finds it is in the best interest of tribal member, Janet Roosevelt Craig, for the Tribe to approve this request.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of tribal member, Janet Roosevelt Craig, to encumber her homesite premises for the purpose of refinancing her home mortgage with Wells Fargo Home Mortgage Company.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JUNE 9, 2010</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
