



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Reducing the Salaries of Members of the Tribal Council)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe is currently going through an unprecedented economic downturn; and
- WHEREAS,** the members of the Tribal Council receive a salary to reimburse them for their efforts on behalf of the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** it has been recommended that the members of the governing body reduce their salaries in this difficult time to lead through example.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reduces the salaries of the members of the governing body by a flat rate of \$10,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this reduction shall become effective immediately.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JULY 27, 2010** duly adopted by a vote of **TEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
