



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Temporarily Placing Ramon Riley on the School Board of the Theodore Roosevelt School)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has heard the concerns of several parents of students attending the Theodore Roosevelt School (TRS) and their feelings towards the members of the School Board; and
- WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 07-2010-203 removed all existing members of the Theodore Roosevelt School Board; and
- WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 07-2010-204 appointed new members of the Theodore Roosevelt School Board; and
- WHEREAS,** it has been recommended that one member of the previous School Board remain on to ensure consistency and enable the seamless transition between School Boards; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Tribe and the Students of the TRS that Ramon Riley be placed on the TRS School Board temporarily in place of the parent from the Havasupai Tribe who is to be named later.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ramon Riley be placed on the TRS School Board temporarily in place of the parent from the Havasupai Tribe who is to be named later.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JULY 27, 2010** duly adopted by a vote of **TEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
