



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Providing support to Councilman Clinton Kessay)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has been advised that Councilman Clinton Kessay's wife, Sherry Kessay passed away; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council extends its sincere sympathy to Councilman Clinton Kessay and his family; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council approves to support and assist the Kessay family, as needed; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that such support and assistance is consistent with and pursuant to the Apache way, and is in the best interest of the Tribe and the Kessay family.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby provides support and assistance to Councilman Clinton Kessay's family, as needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and any prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 20, 2010, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
