

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Supporting the Wildfire Prevention Plan Implemented by the Fort Apache Agency)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache

Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all

matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, human caused fires on the reservation continue to pose a threat to the lives, property, cultural

and natural resources of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the wildfire prevention program for Fort Apache Agency is managed within the Wildland Fire

and Aviation Management Program and the overall mission of the wildfire prevention program

is to reduce human caused wildfires across the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Agency is required to prepare a Wildfire Prevention Plan (WFPP) to

implement wildfire prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Wildfire Prevention Plan provides strategies to assist agency staff in coordination with

Tribal entities to reduce the incidents of unwanted human caused wildfires on the reservation;

and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the Wildfire Prevention Plan as implemented by the Fort Apache

Agency is in the best interests of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the Wildfire Prevention Plan implemented by the Fort Apache Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2010</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
